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1. Introduction

Whoa, got quite late before I finished this one!

Now it's a long way until next deadline due to Easter - submitting early while you remember it wouldn't be a bad thing, though - I plan on getting out reminders after Easter, but I may or may not be very pressed for time.

A happy GM writes this - I received orders from 33 out of the 36 teams, basically, that's the 33 teams that are playing. I'm still more than willing to help the remaining three, if you want me to.

Rosedale Open is still led by Lower Tadfield Apocalypse, now with 29 points. Grunts United follow three points behind, and Call of Cthulhu another point behind. At the bottom, we find Car Park Rangers with 9 points, Fishwick Old Contemptibles with 8 points and Coventry now with 5 points.

Crowbury Challenge sees the Ancients run away at the top, now with 16 points, and a three point lead to Pocket Valley Philosophers. New Bremen Cyberdruids and ANU FC follow four points behind the leaders. Bellaire Bataille is led by Grorud Grasshuggers with 17 points, with a four point gap to Toy Town Rovers, and five points to the Blitzball Team. Barrhaven Tournament is a tie between Mishima Zaibatsu and Muppets, both at 17 points, with 5 points down to Trivial Brief Association.

The luckiest team of Rosedale Open is now Jedi Order, followed by Fishwick Old Contemptibles and Grunts United. The unluckiest team of Rosedale Open is Coventry, followed by Saturday Morning FC and Sportfånarna United.

The luckiest team of the league extension is ANU FC, followed by Muppets and the Nightfall Dreamers. The unluckiest team of the league extension is yet again Gangsters United, followed by Dangermouse and Equipe de France.

The home advantage has increased to 9 VP. Match 19 and 20 of Rosedale Open, match 11 and 12 of the other leagues, and the semi finals of the Pembroke Pocal, are played next round.
