I heard from 47 out of 48 teams this time again. However, that doesn't mean I got 47 order sets - still, good to hear from ya :) On a related note, Sofia Inseminators are now without a manager. If anyone would like to take it over (a veritable challenge), let me know.

TV rights money? There was a big majority in favour of that from all levels, even if it wasn't quite unanimous. Most numbers suggested where way higher than my proposed 250-100-50, especially for the Premiership, but I'd like to be careful about it, so we'll start at 250-100-50, and then see how that works out for a bit.

This also spawned a good bit of other input, and I'll mention the best ideas here:

- * Possibility to buy VPs
- * Higher gate receipts for higher divisions
- * An extra cup only open to the top teams (and perhaps formerly retired greats - another chance at beating them!)

Now whether it's obvious or not, I don't know, but all these three require a significant increase in work with the issues - at least until I finish an automated adjudicator and a user interface to go along with it. So I mention them primarily for the future, so people can have a think about it. Anything you like/don't like, feel free to comment.

The 5 Percent Community have returned to lead the Premiership with 13 points, after two straight wins this weekend. Mishima Zaibatsu and Gangsters United follow one point behind. First Men of Rome, Car Park Rangers and Les Gaulois make up the relegation zone, with 5, 4 and 3 points, respectively. The 5 Percent Community are now luckiest, whereas Car Park Rangers were unlucky again and have expanded their unluck lead over Les Gaulois considerably.

In Lexington League, Alphabet FC now lead alone with 14 points, having distanced Extreme with two points. Tamriel Athletic snuck between them, one point behind the Letters.
