Two managers did not submit orders this time. Sofia Inseminators are still without a manager. If anyone would like to take it over (a veritable challenge), let me know.

With several top teams stumbling this issue, Mishima Zaibatsu now have a three point lead on The 5 Percent Community. The other top teams are two points behind second again - Gangsters United, G.I.D. and Sleep Wanderers all have 18 points. In the relegation zone, we find Car Park Rangers with 10 points, Erkrath Gladiators with 9 points and Les Gaulois with 6 points. There are three teams on 11 points, though, so distance to safe ground isn't long. Les Gaulois have now dethroned the Powers as the unluckiest team of the Premiership, whereas The 5 Percent Community hang on to the unluckiest crown.

Alphabet FC still top Lexington League, leading with 24 points. Extreme still follow two points behind, and after another two straight losses, Tamriel Athletic are now seven points behind.
