Three managers silent this time as well.

We're nearing the end of the season, so I'd like to hear back from you with regards to whether you want to continue with all your teams or if you want to drop some. Now is also a good time to tell potential new players about the game. I'm sure we can find room for your friends :)

The title race in the Premiership is now down to two clubs, with Mishima Zaibatsu far ahead of G.I.D. These clubs plus FC Asskickers have the medal positions for now, but Sleep Wanderers are only three points behind third place. Other clubs look too far behind to compete. In the relegation race, Car Park Rangers will be relegated for sure if they don't win their last four matches, and even if they do, survival seems unlikely. The other relegation spots are still uncertain, though, but will most likely go to two out of Extreme (15), FC Mokum (15), Alphabet FC (14), Twin Peaks Owls (14) and Kremlin (12). With Kremlin's purchase this week, perhaps



they can climb to safe ground? Twin Peaks Owls are in trouble, though, with three suspensions in the key match against Alphabet FC. Sleep Wanderers is the only truly lucky team in the Premiership, whereas both Alphabet FC and Kremlin have had more bad luck than SW's luck. Truly, two unfortunate teams.

In Lexington League, it will be very surprising if the top three spots don't go to Studs First FC, First Men of Rome and Fjortoft's Friends. The latter two will fight for the second place, while the Legbreakers will promote from first place. Slartibartfast FC, Tamriel Athletic and the Ages are all five points behind second and third, so it is possible for them to catch up if one of the top teams have a bad finish of the season. At the bottom, Greensleeves United are already relegated to Berkeley Conference, but every team from fourth to eleventh could still follow them down. Whereas nobody have been terribly unlucky in Kirkwood, Dead Dino Storage have had most of what there was. Luck has primarily gravitated to Aa Fotballklubb and Gamblers United.

Sleep Wanderers are still luckiest, now followed by Dummys and Sjokoladen BK. The worst luck is now that of Alphabet FC, followed by Call of Cthulhu and Kremlin.
