This time, I got orders from 46 of the 48 teams.

In the Rosedale Premiership, Blue Revolution and Mishima Zaibatsu top with 18 points, while Dummys have 17 points. Closest to the medal position holders are FC Asskickers with 15, whereas both FC Mokum and The Ages are just one more point behind. Ladida FC (7), Famous Battles (6) and Extreme (1) make up the relegation zone, while the lowest teams on safe ground have 11. A bit to catch up, but not impossible, at least for the top two in the relegation zone. No changes on the luck front; The Ages are lucky, Extreme are unlucky.

Springfield United now lead Lexington League alone with 19 points. Kremlin follow just one point behind, while Dead Dino Storage are two points behind. Sleep Wanderers and Desassossego Blues are real close too, just one point behind third. The strugglers are Gamblers United, Tamriel Athletic and G.I.D., with 6, 4 and 1 points respectively. The only other relegation candidate at this point is Al Rassan United, who are holding 9<sup>th</sup> place with 9 points. Here too,

like the Premiership, we have a status quo on the karma front. Sleep Wanderers being the lucky ones, Gamblers United should've had more points.

Remaining in a solid lead, the Potato People are looking real likely for promotion. With 22 points, they top Berkeley three points ahead of Call of Cthulhu. PSV hold the last promotion spot with 17 points. In the relegation zone, we find Slartibartfast FC and AZ with 7 points each, and the Professors of Jazz who finally got their first point. Thinkers FC are also in a precarious position, just one point ahead of Slartibartfast FC and AZ. No shifts in luck here either; PSV are favoured by Trion, whereas it's obvious our dear monster doesn't have a liking for Jazz.

Kirkwood Showdown featured a deathmatch between the top two teams, and Fantasy Finale beat Night Owls by 3-2 in both of them. After that, they pushed their former main rivals down to third. So the leading trio is now Fantasy Finale (22), Sjokoladen BK (17) and Night Owls (15). Interchangeable Parts have 15 points too, but a weaker goal difference. Even after winning a game this round, NRNBC still hold last place, now with four points. However, the distance up to safe ground has shortened to two points. All divisions have apparently kept luck where it was, as Fantasy Finale remain luckiest and Ergodic Theorems remain unluckiest.

Sleep Wanderers are still luckiest of the league system, followed by PSV and the Ages. Professors of Jazz are still unluckiest, still followed by Extreme and Gamblers United.

The home advantage has increased to 8 VP. In the next issue, rounds 13 and 14 will be played. In addition, the Rosedale Knockout Quarter Finals will take place.
