Had more technical issues with making this issue. I guess I'll have to do Rosedale Open on the old laptop if this continues. Some Berkeley Conference team sheets became bugged, but I've recovered them from my backup copy of the Rosedale Open files and edited the match effects manually. I've gone over the resulting sheets twice to check for mistakes, but if there's something weird about them, please let me know (there is no reason to worry about your team sheet unless you play in Berkeley Conference).

Like last time, three managers didn't submit orders.

Blue Revolution have a one point lead on the other top teams in the Premiership, Twin Peaks Owls, Mishima Zaibatsu, Springfield United and Kremlin. If the world was fair, though, it would be Springfield United up there. Struggling a bit so far are Fjortoft's Friends and Ladida FC with 2 points each, Dead Dino Storage with 1 point and the Ages without points. The luckiest so far are Twin Peaks Owls, while the unluckiest are Fjortoft's Friends.
