14. GM's ramble

Three managers missed the deadline this time. Better than last week, but I hope for improvement still!

With Twin Peaks Owls beating Mishima Zaibatsu this round, Blue Revolution and Mishima Zaibatsu tie for top with 34 points each. FC Mokum follow third with 25, one point ahead of FC Asskickers and three ahead of Kremlin. Ladida FC are already relegated, while two of the following three will join them: Dummys (14), the Ages (14) and Dead Dino Storage (12). None of them meet each other or Ladida, so whoever can pull off a nice last week is likely to prevail. The luckiest is still FC Mokum. In fact, the top four teams are all among the five luckiest of the Premiership this season. I guess the old saying holds true, the good are lucky? Dummys have been unluckiest.

Lexington have their first promoted team decided; Desassossego Blues will play in the Premiership next season. They'll have to wait until next round to find out if they will also be the Lexington champions, though. Behind them, the race is incredibly tight. Two more teams will promote, but five teams fight for those slots. They are Time Will Tell (26), Car Park Rangers (25), Erkrath Gladiators, Sheffield Thursday and Gamblers United (all 24).
