This time, all active managers submitted orders. Great!

There is a change of management: Michael Hellige has taken over Fantasy Finale. Good luck!

FC Asskickers' lead increased from two to three points this round, so their lock on the gold medals is getting significant. But with four games to go, things can still change. Mishima Zaibatsu follow three points behind. Blue Revolution in third are six points behind, two points ahead of Twin Peaks Owls. In the relegation race, three teams are falling a bit behind. FC Mokum (12), Dummys (11) and Springfield United (10) need strong finishes to stay up. Time Will Tell are luckiest of the Premiership, while Springfield United are unluckiest.

The Potato People keep stumbling, now only having taken two points on the last eight matches. They still lead, though, with 27 points to second placed Night Owls' 24. In the race for the third place, the Ages (22), Car Park Rangers (22), Sheffield Thursday (21) and Dead Dino Storage (20) all have decent chances. Harestua IL had a good round of three points and climb to tenth, two points from safe ground. They're chased by Call of Cthulhu two points behind, while Ladida FC are hopelessly lost at the bottom. Car Park Rangers are luckiest, while Call of Cthulhu take over the bad luck lead as Dead Dino Storage falls down to fourth on that list.

Extreme have mounted a credible runaway in Berkeley Conference, and with 27 points and just 4 games to go, they look very likely champions. The primary challengers are also the most likely to promote along with them; Feyenoord (24), St. Helens (24) and Ergodic Theorems (23) remain in contention. The bottom three are losing ground to the rest of the division, and First Men of Rome was the only of the bottom three to take points this round. Extreme are now luckiest, while Drawmongers FC are still unluckiest.

Interchangeable Parts lead Kirkwood Showdown with 27 points, but are now just two points ahead of Greensleeves United. Queen in third have 23, while Saturday Morning FC and Coventry are just one point behind Queen. The last place of doom is all but claimed by Dispelliarmus FC - to survive, they now need at least three wins during the last four games, and they have none from the first 18 matches. Fantasy Finale remain luckiest, while Tamriel Athletic remain unluckiest.
