14. GM's ramble

This weekend, Erkrath Gladiators probably made sure they'll win both the Rosedale Premiership and become the luckiest team of the division. FC Asskickers and Blue Revolution follow closest, but are five points behind with six games to go. The relegation zone is now all but ready for Lexington, with Twin Peaks Owls holding the last safe place on 14, while Gamblers United (8), Ergodic Theorems (6) and the Potato People (5) are below the line. Erkrath Gladiators are now luckiest, almost three times as lucky as the second luckiest team. Blue Revolution remain unluckiest, though FC Asskickers is catching up on that.

After two weak rounds, Feyenoord claim two wins and strengthens their claim on the first place. Erkrath Gladiators are now luckiest, followed by Thinkers FC and Car Park Rangers. Saturday Morning FC are now unluckiest, followed by Blue Revolution and Famous Battles.
