14. GM's ramble

Three managers did not submit orders this time. Sofia Inseminators are still without a manager. If anyone would like to take it over (a veritable challenge), let me know.

Like last week, several top teams dropped points in the Premiership, and Mishima Zaibatsu now have a five point lead on The 5 Percent Community. Sleep Wanderers now hold third alone with 20 points - two behind second. In the relegation zone, we find Twin Peaks Owls with 12 points, Erkrath Gladiators with 11 points and Les Gaulois with 8 points, but Car Park Rangers also have 12 points, and a better goal difference. Les Gaulois are still the unluckiest team of the Premiership, whereas The 5 Percent Community hang on to the luckiest crown.

Alphabet FC (28) and Extreme (25) top Lexington League, both almost promoted already. The race for third place is veritable, though, with Tamriel Athletic and Blue Revolution on 19 points,

and FC Asskickers and Feyenoord on 18 points. At the bottom, we find Sheffield Thursday with 9 points, Brazil Star Conquerors with 8 points and PSV with 6 points. Studs First FC are still luckiest of Berkeley, whereas Harestua IL are still unluckiest by far.

FC United lead Kirkwood Showdown with 27 points. Springfield United follow closest with 26, whereas Dummys have 22 points. Sofia Inseminaters still trail with 4 points, still having two points up to the Interchangeable Parts. FC United are now luckiest, whereas March of the Black Queen are still unluckiest.

Luckiest of all are Alphabet FC, followed by Studs First FC and Slartibartfast FC. Harestua IL are unluckiest by far, followed by Les Gaulois and Fjortoft's Friends.

The home advantage is still 8 VP. In the next issue, rounds 17 and 18 will be played. The Rosedale Knockout semi finals will also take place.
