The Premiership is now led by Dummys alone. They have 10 points. Blue Revolution follow with nine, whereas four teams have seven each: FC Mokum, Mishima Zaibatsu, First Men of Rome and the Ages. In the relegation zone, we find Famous Battles and Ladida FC with four points each, and Extreme still without points. The Ages are luckiest of the Premiership still, whereas Extreme are now unluckiest.

The leading duo in Lexington hangs on; Springfield United and Dead Dino Storage still lead together, now with ten points each. Desassossego Blues and Car Park Rangers are closest, two points behind. Three teams are trailing already; Gamblers United with 2, G.I.D. with 1 and Tamriel Athletic with 0 points. Noone else are under 6 points. Sleep Wanderers still stay lucky, whereas Gamblers United remain unlucky.

Berkeley Conference features the only team to still have won all the league games: The Potato People. Four points behind, we have three chasers: Call of Cthulhu, Saturday Morning FC and Harestua IL.
