Firearms

Grade A bang bang can be hard to acquire. However, sometimes one finds sweet loot – and not so sweet loot. Here's some firearms-related equipment found during the current Shadowrun campaign.

Heavy Pistols

Steiner-Bisley Zenith Mark II

This heavily customized weapon was "liberated" from a Hispanic razor king that was subsequently extracted by a DocWagon HTR (High-Threat Response) V-thrust vehicle.

Steiner-Bisley is a wholly owned subsidiary of Ares, acquired a few years back. The brand was kept because of its long tradition in Europe, and Ares looking to compete against Saeder-Krupp in Europe using an European brand. So far, Ares haven't made any large inroads into the European market, but Steiner-Bisley continue making excellent firearms for the discerning customer.

The stock Zenith mark II has a built-in point of recoil compensation because of its ergonomic design, as well as an internal Smartlink 2 system.

The customized Zenith mark II "found" had a custom finish (chromed and matte black), a Steiner-Bisley factory silencer, a personalized grip, a low-light flashlight, and no trigger (ensuring that only someone with smartlink cyberware can fire the weapon).

SMGs

Brügger & Thomet MP12

This heavily customized weapon was "liberated" from a Hispanic razor king that was subsequently extracted by a DocWagon HTR (High-Threat Response) V-thrust vehicle.

Brügger & Thomet AG is a Swiss defense supplier specializing in the design and manufacturing of firearms and tactical components such as sound suppressors and rail systems, supplying actors such as Heckler & Koch, Aimpoint, Surefire, and others. Ostensibly, the firm is still independent, but there's been rumors that they're about to be the target of a takeover from Saeder-Krupp. Though a small firm, their products represent the pinnacle of European firearms engineering – or so their ad-copy says.

The stock MP12 is a very compact and lightweight Smartlink 2 enabled SMG in advanced materials. It has a bullpup configuration, with a built-in heavy barrel, rigid stock, and 2 points of built-in recoil compensation in addition to a foregrip, making for a very controllable weapon.

The customized MP12 "found" had an engraving of a nude pinup riding a bullet, an extended 40round clip, an ultrasound sight and a sound suppressor, as well as a biometric safety system on a personalized grip.

Vehicles

Ricardo's 2056 Toyota Elite ElectricR



Ricardo managed to acquire this later model (2056) Toyota Elite from a source that didn't *explicitly* tell from where this vehicle was ... liberated. It is almost a certainty that someone's looking for this car from somewhere. Ricardo's Elite is the 'ElectricR' version, with a lower cargo handling and no Troll-friendliness, but with an enhanced electric engine and an excellent range.

The Elite is a luxury vehicle that has managed to stay updated and relevant. The integrated electronics package is capable of handling any current generation software upgrades, and its user interface is quite intuitive to most users.

This particular Elite is equipped with the "performance package", which includes a datajack, four bucket seats, and roll bars (3 dice to any character's damage resistance test following a crash), and a superconductive drive (rating 2 turbocharging).



"Skidz", Schneider's Land-Rover 2048



Schneider's new set of wheels is actually a moonshiner's car. It used to run moonshine and awakened plants up north, over the border. Schneider got it repainted, so that it currently sports a dark pink flames on light pink background paint scheme (not shown).

The Land-Rover 2048 is a robust off-road vehicle. Its synthahol engine gives it great range and reliability. The suspension's significantly upgraded with heavy-duty shocks, and the troll-size rearmost bench seat and the equally oversize seatbelts installed makes sure that passengers of an extra-large persuasion has plenty of room.

Modifications installed include heavy-duty shocks, nitrous boost (+30 speed for 5 turns, +2/+2 handling), armoring (with extra ballistic blankets installed in the rear compartment), and a roof-mounted loading rail.

Armor and Armor Modifications

Jinx' chemical protection catsuit

Deadbeat included a small and cheap chemical protection catsuit for Jinx in the order that Vince handled. It isn't particularly expensive, and is semi-disposable (in the sense that since it is worn *under* clothes or other armor, it will likely have to be discarded if heavily contaminated), but can be very useful if one needs at least *some* protection against chemical agents such as skin irritants and so on.

This suit is skin-tight Spandex-like, coated with chemical seal. Chemical seal protects against liquid-based chemical attacks. The suit has 2 points of chemical seal, and each point of chemical seal reduces by 1 the Power of contact-vector compounds.
